The State Sir Executive Committee requires the following regarding attendance at our July "Ladies Luncheon:"

- 1. Branches shall require attendees (Ladies are included) to show the original, a copy, or photo (in hardcopy or via a phone) of their vaccination record cards or test result documentation.
- 2. Branches shall maintain an updated list of members (ladies are included) who have submitted proof of vaccination and use it to check them in for branch activities involving any indoor components.
- 3. Branches shall require all Attendees attending SIR indoor activities, to execute a waiver prior to allowing a member to attend such activities.

Pardini's Restaurant will be using the following as their protocols for our July Ladies luncheon:

- 1. No social distancing and no masking expected or required.
- 2. There will be complimentary wine at each table.
- 3. All luncheon protocols return to those which existed prior to the coronavirus shutdown.

Obvious Conflict: The CDC and California are moving forward with a dramatic reopening as of June 15.

However, until further notice from our State Sir Executive Committee, we are expected to comply with the existing protocols to "minimize SIR's exposure to possible claims related to Pandemic diseases."

Pool Group




