Distribution: All Big Sirs

December 15, 2021

Gentlemen,

California Department of Public Health (CDPH) issued a revised guidance on face coverings. Although styled as a guidance, the document states that the CDPH "is requiring masks to be worn in all indoor public settings, irrespective of vaccine status, for the next four weeks (December 15, 2021 through January 15, 2022).

This is issued Statewide.

If you have any indoor "public" events between now and January 15, please adhere to this guidance.

#### SIR BRANCH COVID PROTOCOLS

#### The Gateway Chapter 169

BRANCH PROTOCOLS FOR MINIMIZING COVID-19 LIABILITY In view of the deletion by SIR's insurance carrier, effective May 1, 2021, of coverage for pandemic diseases and the likelihood that other carriers are also not providing such coverage, the following requirements are necessary to protect the health and safety of SIR members and minimize SIR's exposure to possible claims related to pandemic diseases:

- 1. The branches are required to strictly observe corporate formalities, such as annual election of officers and keeping corporate minutes in a timely and orderly manner.
- 2. The branches are urged to encourage all branch members to be vaccinated against COVID-19 and to help those branch members who need assistance in finding vaccination centers and getting vaccinated.
- 3. 3. Beginning May 1, 2021 and until further notice to the contrary, branches shall require branch members, visiting SIR members from other branches, guest speakers, guests, and spouses/ significant others ("Attendees") to be fully vaccinated (2 shots, if required) as a condition of being allowed to attend branch activities which are conducted wholly or partially indoors. In the alternative, unvaccinated Attendees can attend such activities if they provide proof of a negative COVID-19 test administered within 3 days prior to an event they want to attend.
- 4. To ensure compliance with the requirements of item 3, branches shall require Attendees to show the original, a copy, or photo (in hardcopy or via a phone) of their vaccination record cards or test result documentation.
- 5. 5. Branches shall maintain an updated list of members who have submitted proof of vaccination and use it to check them in for branch activities involving any indoor components. Branches need not require members who are on the vaccinated list to show proof of vaccination thereafter.
- 6. 6. Branches shall require all Attendees participating in SIR activities to comply with all then-current state and county requirements related to COVID-19 protection, such as wearing masks and social distancing.
- 7. 7. Branches shall require all Attendees attending SIR indoor or outdoor activities, to execute the attached waiver prior to allowing a member to attend such activities. Such waiver need only be executed once by a member, and the branch shall maintain the originals of such executed waivers for inspection by State SIR representatives.

### SIR EVENT WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY FOR EXPOSURE TO COVID-19

Due to the Covid-19 pandemic and the general unavailability of insurance to cover liability related to that matter, the SIR branch listed above ("Branch") is requiring members, visiting SIR members from other branches, guest speakers, guests, and spouses/significant others attending events sponsored by the Branch or by Sons in Retirement, Incorporated ("State Sir") to agree to the following:	
1.	In attending activities sponsored by the Branch or State SIR, the undersigned agrees to comply with mask, social distancing, and other Covid-19 protocols required by applicable government bodies, the Branch, State SIR, and the applicable venue. Failure to do so will result in the attendee being asked to leave the event.
2.	Regardless of adherence to mandated protocols, requirements, recommendations, and vaccinations, the undersigned acknowledges that there is a risk of Covid-19 exposure whenever an individual enters a public space, a building with other people, or a group of other individuals.
3.	Knowing the foregoing risk, the undersigned assumes the risk of Covid-19 exposure and accepts sole responsibility for any exposure to Covid-19 and resulting health conditions that may occur due to attendance at a Branch or State SIR event.
4.	The undersigned hereby releases and holds harmless the Branch, State SIR, and their respective officers, directors, and members from any and all responsibility for illness, death, or other losses arising from exposure to Covid-19 at a Branch or State SIR event.

EXECUTIVE BOARD MEETING ZOOM MEETING, RECAP

There was no official Board Meeting held in December. However an emergency Board meeting was held via Zoom on December 22, 2021 to discuss several key issues.

First: Increase in price for lunch at Pardini's. Together with the price increase and the need to insure a smooth and efficient check-in procedure it was determined that the luncheon fee would be set at \$20.00. This will include the meal cost and a portion of the annual dues. Those that may have already paid their full annual dues will have their dues returned or you can simply us that to pay for one of your monthly lunches.

Second: Mask Requirement. The State of California has implemented a masking requirement through January 15, 2022. As required by the State SIR announcement, all SIR indoor functions must comply with the masking requirement. Since our January luncheon is within the time frame we will require masks to be worn upon entry, but as soon as you are seated masks may then be removed.

Lastly: Our February luncheon will not be held on our typical 2nd Tuesday, scheduling issue with Pardini's. So the board has decided to reschedule for either the 2nd Monday or Wednesday. We will advise you as to the new date as soon as finalized.




