Here's a little history on the July's Guest Speakers,

Lieutenant Colonel Linda Phillips and Colonel Scott Phillips U.S. Air Force retired. Both were KC-135 air refueling pilots with over 7000 flying hours between the two of them to include combat and combat support mission time. Linda was among the first 50 female Air Force pilots when that career field reopened to women in the 1970s. Both served in Europe and the Pacific theaters. Linda commanded two flying squadrons in England. Scott commanded a flying squadron in England and was an acting Wing Commander in North Dakota; he also served in Iraq and Afghanistan. After retirement, Scott taught Junior ROTC at Duncan and Clovis East High Schools. Scott and Linda became members of the Central Valley Honor Flight's board of directors after they served as travel guardians to five World War II and Korean War veterans. They have also been volunteers at Castle Air Museum since 1981.

SIR 169 EXECUTIVE BOARD MEETING MINUTES Date: June 11, 2024

Big SIR called the meeting to order at 10:00 am

BIG SIR REPORT: 1) Ernie reported that on 6/20, State SIR was convening a meeting via Zoom regarding changes forthcoming in the SIR organization. All are invited to attend, 2) He futured shared that there is some concern among members of the BEC, that some of our members have not been receiving information due to the possibility that the phone numbers that we have been in our files are either missing of no longer valid. Howard Jones had raised this issue from his experience in attempting to contact members to obtain missing Roster data. Bernie reported that this has not been the case and that all of the members on his lists have been called and they all seemed to have been contacted successfully. Discussion ensued with the suggestion that we explore sending out meeting and other information via email, an approach which both Ed Dorn has successfully used in this communications with golfers and dine out participants, and Ted Fox has employed in the distribution of the Newsletter. Big SIR proposed that we test this approach by using email to gain the July luncheon counts from a third of the membership, then determine how best to go forward based on our experience with this approach. Approved by consensus.

LITTLE SIR REPORT: On behalf of Little SIR, John Eleazarian, who was not able to be present at today's meeting, Luis Rodriquez reported: 1) Todays program will feature Valerie Salcedo, who is an alumna of Sunnyside High Schools and Fresno States Music Programs. She is a very talented singer who has performed on stage as lead cast member of a major musical program; sang with the Fresno Opera; performs at military presentations and is significantly involved in the Honor Flight Program. 2) Several men who have been significantly involved in the development of the Castle Air museum will be providing the program.

SECRETARY REPORT: Jim Forden reported: 1) Currently, we have 155 inducted and Active Members. 2) Out of personal curiosity, Jim reported that he had scanned all of the membership applications that we now have on file, to take an sampling of the kinds of activities that are of greatest interest to our members. A summary of this data was distributed to the BEC.

Checkbook balance at month end \$10,1288.54 MSC to accept the Report as submitted.

ACTIVITIES: Ed Dorn reported that: 1) Details of all three dining out activities which are being offered by our Chapter will be found on the back table. 2) Golf is now halfway through the outings scheduled for this year and similarly halfway through the champion-ship series for our Chapter. 3) Regarding the establishment of a broader array of activities available to our membership, it has been our experience in the past that finding persons to organize and drive these efforts is difficult.

MEMBERSHIP: Jim Hiney reported that he now has several applications from persons who have been approved for induction. Today, an application was received from Rod Noll, who is being sponsored by his father, John Noll. Jim proposed that Rod Noll be approved for induction, and will so be inducted if present at the luncheon today. MSC to approve Rod Noll for induction and his induction and that of the others who have been approved will take place when next present at a luncheon.

SUNSHINE REPORT: Bernie Hollenbeck reported that: 1) He had called in a total of 100 for todays luncheon. 2) He then reported that Dave Dias is now experiencing some medical difficulties at this time and requested that we keep him in our thoughts and prayers.


