BIG SIR REPORT: 1) Ernie Sopp asked if there had been any response from the Membership, following the publishing of a piece in the <u>Newsletter</u> regarding the caution against using the information in our Directory for comericial purposes. None had been heard by members of our BEC. .2) <u>Big Sir reminded that a slate of officers for 2025 should be identified by August of this year.</u>

LITTLE SIR REPORT: Little SIR, John Eleazarian,: reported that 1) the Nominating Committee will be formed and the work completed by the deadline set by the Big SIR. 2) day's speaker is Lisa Smittcamp, the, District Attorney for Fresno County.and next month, the singer, Valery Saucedo will be performing at our meeting. 3) Wine has been purchased for our luncheon prizes at a good price, with quality ratings.

SECRETARY REPORT: Jim Forden reported: 1) Currently, we have 156 inducted and Active Members. 2) The work being accomplished to complete the Roster database has proceeded to a point that there are now only 20 members for whom data is yet needed.

TREASURE'S REPORT: On behalf of Nick Lopez who would not be in attendance today, Duane Evans distributed our Treasury Statement for April 2024 which reported that with Luncheon Revenues, Dues collected and 50/50 proceeds there was a total of \$2,448.00.00 of Income for the month of March. Expenses for the period totaled \$2,378.28, leaving a Balance of funds (including Petty Cash) of \$10,235.63.. MSC to accept the Report as submitted.

ACTIVITIES: Ed Dorn reported that: 1) The recently publicized Area wide tournament to be held in Fresno, has been canceled due to a lack of signups for the event. 2} The long time treasurer of the Golf Committee, Joe Doherty,.,who has served the program for several years has withdrawn from the assignment and will be replaced by Nick Lopez...3) There are now two opportunities for our members to play pool, one offered, at the Windham Senior facility and a second at the Clovis Senior Center.





How can I keep my bones strong as I age?

There are things you can do at any age to prevent weakened bones. Here are some tips:

**Eat foods that support bone health.** Get enough <u>calcium, vitamin D</u>, and protein each day. Low-fat dairy; leafy green vegetables; fish; and fortified juices, milk, and grains are good sources of calcium. If your vitamin D level is low, talk with your doctor about taking a <u>supplement</u>.

**Get active.** Choose <u>weight-bearing exercise</u>, such as strength training, walking, hiking, jogging, climbing stairs, tennis, and dancing. This type of physical activity can help build and strengthen your bones.

**Don't smoke.** Smoking increases your risk of weakened bones. If you do smoke, quit, contact your doctor for recommended ways to quit.


**Limit alcohol consumption.** Too much alcohol can harm your bones. Drink in moderation or not at all.
