SIR 169 EXECUTIVE BOARD MEETING MINUTES Date: July 9, 2024

Big SIR called the meeting to order at 10:05 am

BIG SIR/LITTLE SIR REPORT: 1) Representing Big SIR Ernie who was not present today, Little SIR John Eleazarian provided a summary report of the recent SIR statewide Zoom meeting. Those who attended the session provided the following observations: a) The purpose of the session was to inform, rather than seek input re intended changes in the image and future approach of SIR as an organization. First the moderator of the session explained that as a viable organization and to gain membership, the title, logo and officer titles of the leadership needed to be changed to present a less unique nature. It is argued that in doing so, SIR would become attractive to a broader segment of the population. Discussion ensued, with consensus that as opposed to changing the image of SIR, the current membership needs to be more active in the recruitment of new members. To the present, our most successful recruitment of new members has been the result of referrals from our existing membership. This would suggest that going forward, our efforts should be to focused on better meeting the needs of our existing members, so that they in turn will be motivated to encourage friends, family and other acquaintances to join. Quality programs, activities, and expanded opportunities for social interaction should be our commitment. 2) As a lead into the Zoom session, it was proposed by the State leadership that to improve the financial health of the organization, SIR should change its Corporate status to allow the organization to actively solicit funding from external sponsors. This idea was briefly discussed during our Board meeting with no action taken either to support or question this proposal.

MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING: MSC to approve with the following changes: Delete: "Both Linda and Scott have been with the Central Valley Honor Flight doing all the organizing of the flights. Scott and Linda are the ones also significantly involved with the development of Castle Air Museum". Add:"Valerie Saucedo, who provided the program for out last meeting so entertainingly, has offered to return and perform for us at the next Valentines Day to which we will be inviting our ladies."

SECRETARY REPORT: Jim Forden reported: 1) Currently, we have 157 inducted and Active Members. 2) There are just 4 members who have reported that they do not have email addresses. Discussion followed regarding the accuracy of the email information and telephone numbers that we have on file in each of the membership lists maintained for correspondence, distribution of the Newsletter, and use by the luncheon callers.
